NON-CREDIT CHURCH/COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENT: (no credit)

In keeping with the stated mission of the university, the purpose of the church/community service requirement is to cultivate a dedication to service at the local, state, national, and international levels.

Students must register for ZSV 007 and complete a minimum of 20 hours of volunteer service in one semester at an approved site under the supervision of the Service Coordinator in the School of Christian Studies. The Service Coordinator will monitor completion of the service component. Students are required to complete Christian Studies 110 prior to registering for ZSV 007. Normally the student will register for and complete the service component in the senior year. There is no charge for ZSV 007 and no academic credit will be awarded for it, but *satisfactory completion of this requirement is required for graduation.*
