**\*\*\*CHAPEL REQUIREMENTS**

In keeping with the stated mission of the institution, the purpose of chapel is to offer students well-planned programs providing for Christian growth and maturation. Beginning Fall 2008, Chapel ZCH 007 will be required for all enrolled students. Chapel requirements are based on student classification.

Students entering as: freshmen (0-29 hrs.) complete 4 semesters; sophomores (30-59 hrs.) complete 3 semesters; juniors or seniors (60 or more hrs.) complete 1 semester; Students pursuing associate degrees complete 1 semester; students who transfer to the University of Mobile from an institution that requires chapel may transfer credit from that institution. The amount of credit will be determined by the Registrar. Chapel services are conducted during the dedicated Wednesday 11:00 hour. Students are expected to attend all chapel services with 1 absence allowed. Students must register in order to receive credit.
