

International Student Admissions Check-List

Freshmen

- A completed international student application
- A non-refundable application fee of \$50
- An official certificate of completion of secondary school
- An official TOEFL score (Paper-based test score of 500 or better/Computer-based test score of 173 or better/iBT based of 61 or better.) For students whose native language is English, an ACT composite score of 21 or SAT score of 980 is acceptable.
- Immunization certificate for measles and rubella
- Proof of Negative Tuberculosis Skin Test
- A completed Affidavit of Financial Support

Transfers

- A completed international student application
- A non-refundable application fee of \$50
- An official certificate of completion of secondary school (Student with 30 or more acceptable hours from an accredited U.S. institution may be exempt from this requirement.)
- An official TOEFL score (Paper-based score of 500 or better/Computer-based test score of 173 or better.) For students whose native language is English, an ACT composite score of 21 or SAT score of 980 is acceptable. (Student with 30 or more acceptable hours from an accredited U.S. institution may be exempt from this requirement.)
- Final official transcripts from each college previously attended
- An English translation and evaluation of credits must be done for universities located outside of the U.S. The translator and evaluator will be selected by the Admissions Office. Information is enclosed.
- Immunization certificate for measles and rubella
- Proof of Negative Tuberculosis Skin Test
- A completed Affidavit of Financial Support
- If you are currently attending a U.S. institution, you must submit a photocopy of the following:
 - I-20
 - I-94
 - Passport
- Transfer Eligibility Form (for transfer students from U. S. institutions)
